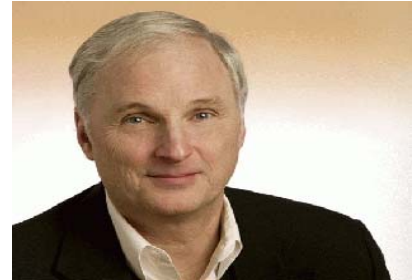


Dennis McMillian
